

Pets Alive provides high quality, affordable spay/neuter services for cats and dogs.

Pets benefit from a lower risk of reproductive cancers. Females will not go into heat and males will be much less likely to mark territory, which makes them more family friendly and keeps them in their forever homes.

Reducing the number of unwanted litters in our communities lessens the burden on local shelters that are sometimes funded by tax dollars. Less unwanted pets results in fewer animals roaming neighborhoods causing destruction to wildlife and property. Pets that have been spayed or neutered are less aggressive and less likely to bite.

Spay and neuter creates a better quality of life for all.
